

Explanation of Contact Lens Services

You are scheduled for an annual comprehensive eye examination today. The exam includes a refraction, glaucoma testing, retinal fundus exam, and overall eye health evaluation. <u>It does not include the contact lens services.</u> Most insurance companies do not fully cover the cost of contact lens services.

There are three levels of contact lens fittings, depending on the type of lens needed and the complexity of the fit. Fees range from \$60 to \$100. The services include: a trial pair of contacts, follow-up appointments and your contact lens prescription, once it has been finalized.

Contact lens follow-up appointments are required to assess the fit of the lens in order to maintain proper corneal health. There is no charge for this appointment. If it has been six months or longer, and the doctor finds a new refraction necessary, there may be a \$30 refraction fee.

Contact lens service fees are non-refundable.
